Dear Shri Sayyadain,

A Muslim correspondent complains to me that the Government policy has taken the shape of getting rid of the Muslim element from all posts of responsibility. He says that you are one of the persons, who are about to be eliminated from the Bombay Province, so that your present office might be held by a Hindu.

Is there any truth in this?

He has a bitter complaint against the way in which not he alone has been treated but says that dirty tricks are resorted to get rid of the Muslim element from the services. Their confidential sheets are spoiled by false or flimsy charges, and secret behind-the-back enquiries are made and so on. They are sacked on the least excuse.

I would like to know your views in the matter.

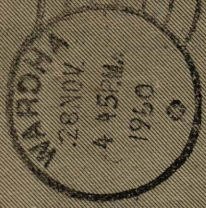

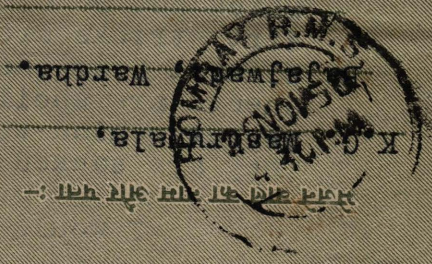
